#### I. CALL TO ORDER AND CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Reynolds Williams called the meeting of the South Carolina Retirement System Investment Commission ("Commission") to order at 9:59 a.m. Chairman Williams introduced and welcomed Mr. David Avant, Executive Director of the Public Employee Benefit Authority ("PEBA"), as the newest member of the Commission. Chairman Williams noted that Mr. Avant would serve as a non-voting, ex officio member of the Commission.
